The 1901 Census records him as an unemployed 20 year old
Won Birmingham League and Walsall Cup medals whilst at Aston Villa, but made no first team appearances
Played in Norwich City's first Southern League match
<i>He is contemplating matrimony and is desirous of settling near his parents in the Midlands (1909)</i>
<i>Never out of form, he is one of the quiet members of the team and plays the game in a thorough sporting manner</i>
Played in Croydon Common's last ever match
Appeared for Croydon Common in 5 minor cup matches, without scoring
Gained Southern League Division 2 and Southern Football Alliance championship honours with Croydon Common
A lifelong teetotaller
Represented the London Combination against Arsenal in the Champions v. The Rest match in May 1916
Was a gas stoker in a steel works and was living at 1 Longcroft Avenue, Wednesbury at the time of his death
Upon probate in Birmingham on 16.4.1964, his widow Lily Beatrice (nee Tildesley) was left an estate valued at £4,283

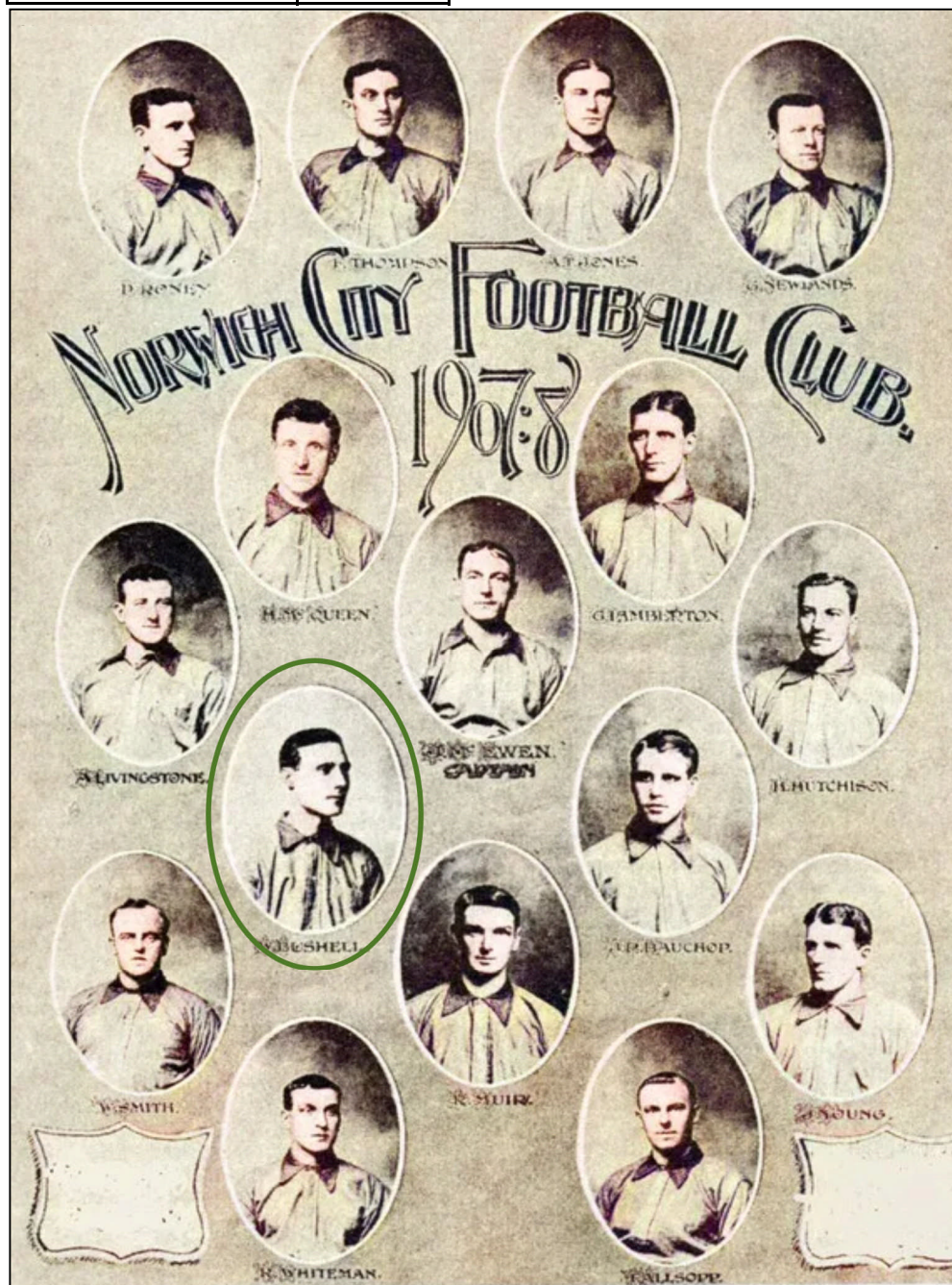

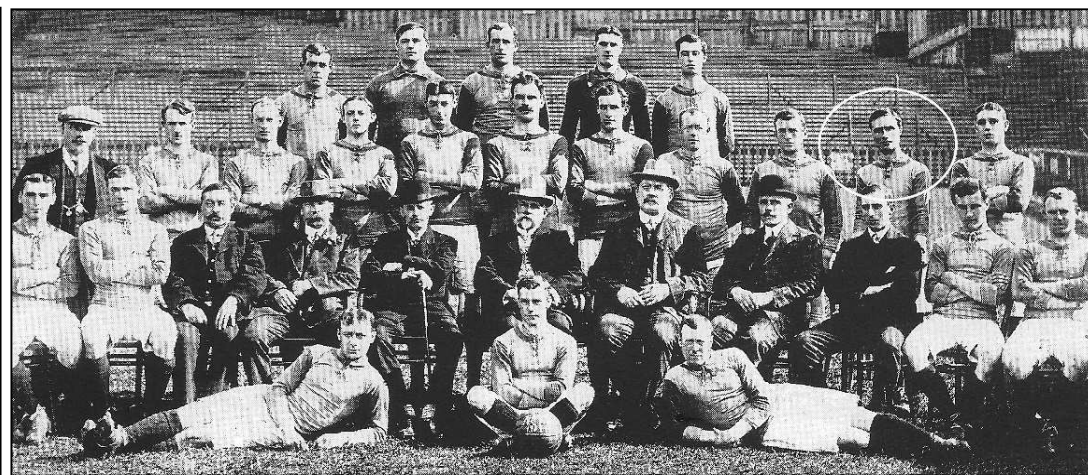

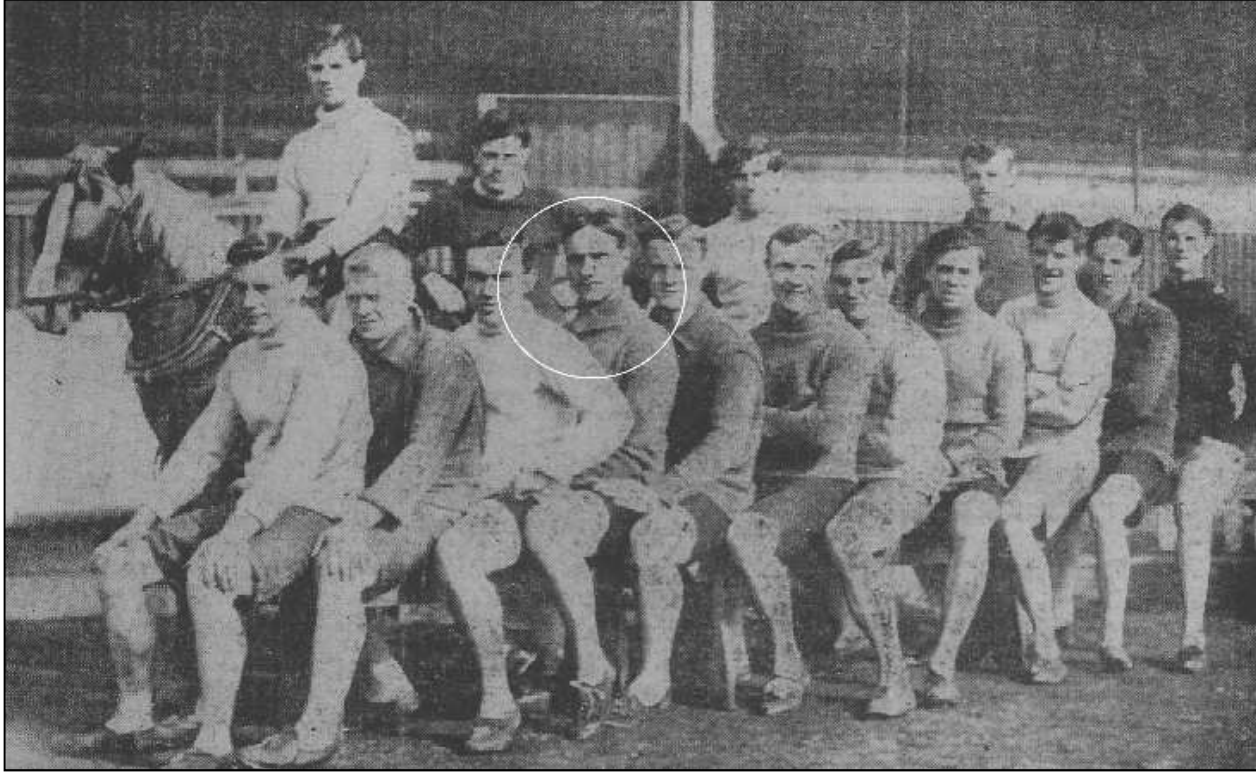
