Was recommended to Southampton by an exiled supporter living in Kent
His contract with Southampton included a requirement to undertake a certain amount of ground maintenance
Played in the professional Croydon Common club's first competitive match and its first F.A. Cup match
The 1911 Census records him as a gas works labourer living at 32 Wiltshire Road with his wife and three children
Was playing for Cray Wanderers (reputedly the second oldest club in the world) in the 1913-14 season
Won more than 40 prizes on the running track
Made 11 appearances in all competitions for Dartford, scoring 5 goals
Was apparently known as "German" at Dartford
Was a gas company servicer by trade and was living at 32 Wiltshire Road, Orpington at the time of his death
Upon probate of his will (28.9.1945 in Llandudno) he left £315.16s.7d to his wife Ellen
