The 1911 Census records him as a professional footballer living at 39 Station Road, Gillingham with his wife Henrietta and children Albert (4 years) and Lillian (4 months)
Played in both matches in the final when Swansea Town won the Welsh Cup in 1912-13; beating Pontypridd 1-0 after a 0-0 draw
Appears to have died intestate
