

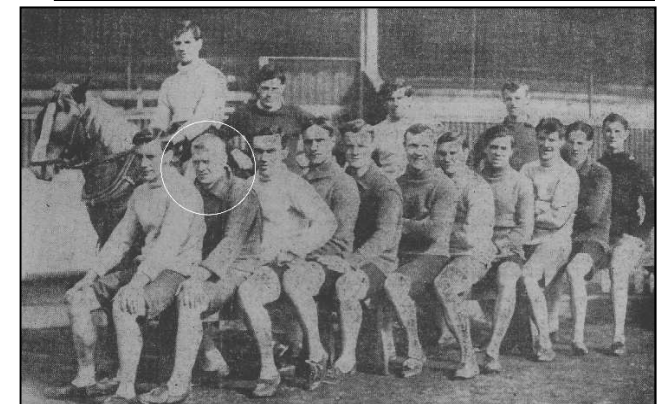

Appeared for Croydon Common in 6 minor cup matches, without scoring
Married Jessie Hornsey in 1910
The 1911 Census records him as a professional footballer, living as a boarder at 215 Wellgate, Rotherham
Gained Southern Football Alliance championship honours with Croydon Common in 1912-13
Played in Margate's only competitive fixture in the abandoned 1914-15 season; a 1-0 away defeat to Sittingbourne in the F.A. Cup
Played 25 matches for Hull City during the war and also assisted Brighton & Hove Albion and Southport
Was part of the Bridlington Town squad that won the East Riding Senior Cup in 1920-21 and 1921-22 and the East Riding County League in 1921-22
The 1921 Census records him as a cupola man working for Barker & Aspey Engineers and living with wife Jessie (31) and children Arthur (10) and Kathleen (5) at 91, Belmont Street, Hull
In 1939 he was a fitter's labourer living with his wife Jessie, daughter Kathleen (23), a clerk, and son George (15), an apprentice coopersmith, at 5 Wynburg Street, Hull
